## **Shorman to Testify Before House Subcommittee**

February 9, 2011 (Hays, Kansas)- Eagle Communications President and CEO Gary Shorman will testify in Washington on Thursday before the House Energy and Commerce Subcommittee on Communications and Technology. The subcommittee hearing chaired by Rep. Greg Walden (R-OR), will hold the hearing at 10 a.m.(EST) in room 2322 of the Rayburn House Office Building.
