



Connecting the Wireless Router

1. Put the router in a central location and keep it away from metal-surrounded environment since metal can hamper signal pick-up.
2. Plug the Ethernet cable from the cable modem into the Internet (or WAN) port on the back of the router. This port is usually located at the back of the router.
3. Connect a computer to the router by plugging one other Ethernet cable into the Ethernet port (usually labeled 1, 2, 3, and 4) in your PC or computer and attaching the opposite end to one of the ports at the back of the router. Then plug the router into an electrical outlet.
4. Wait for the indicator light to stop blinking indicating that the router is done booting up.
5. Restart your computer so it could access a new IP address from the router. Now you have just done performing basic Linksys setup.
