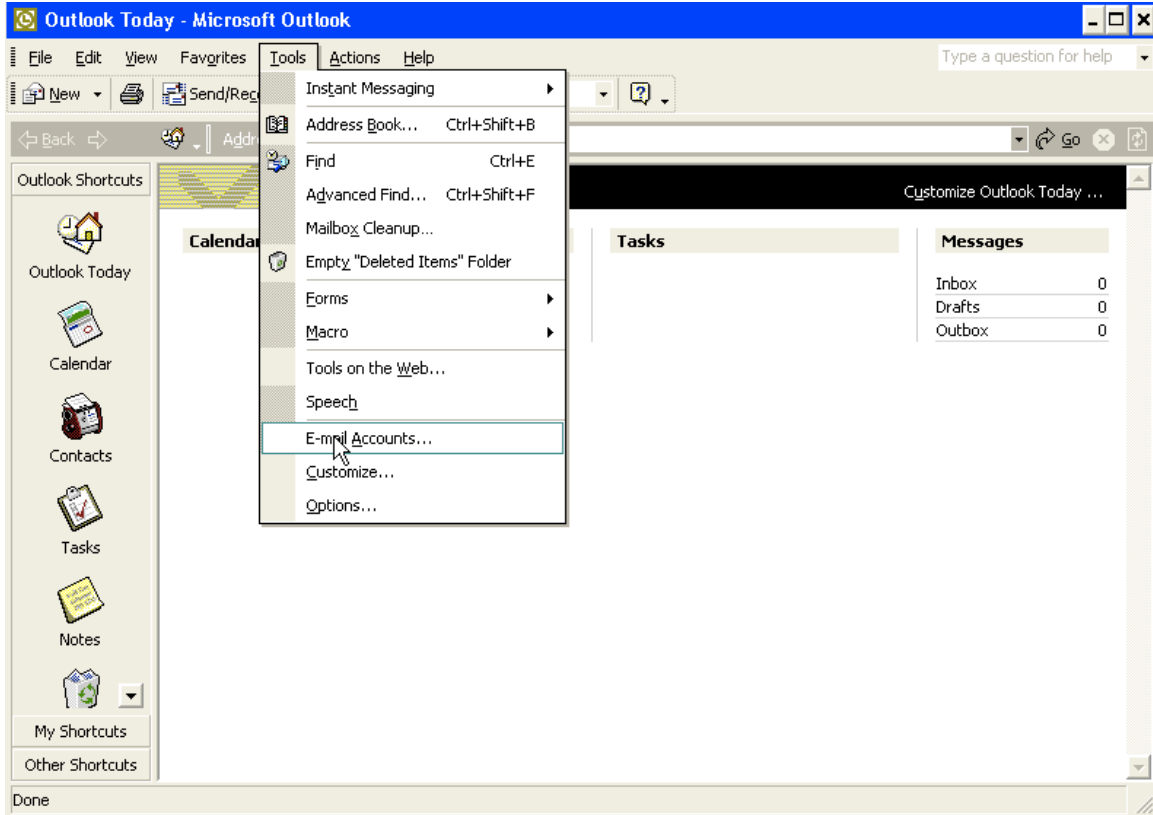
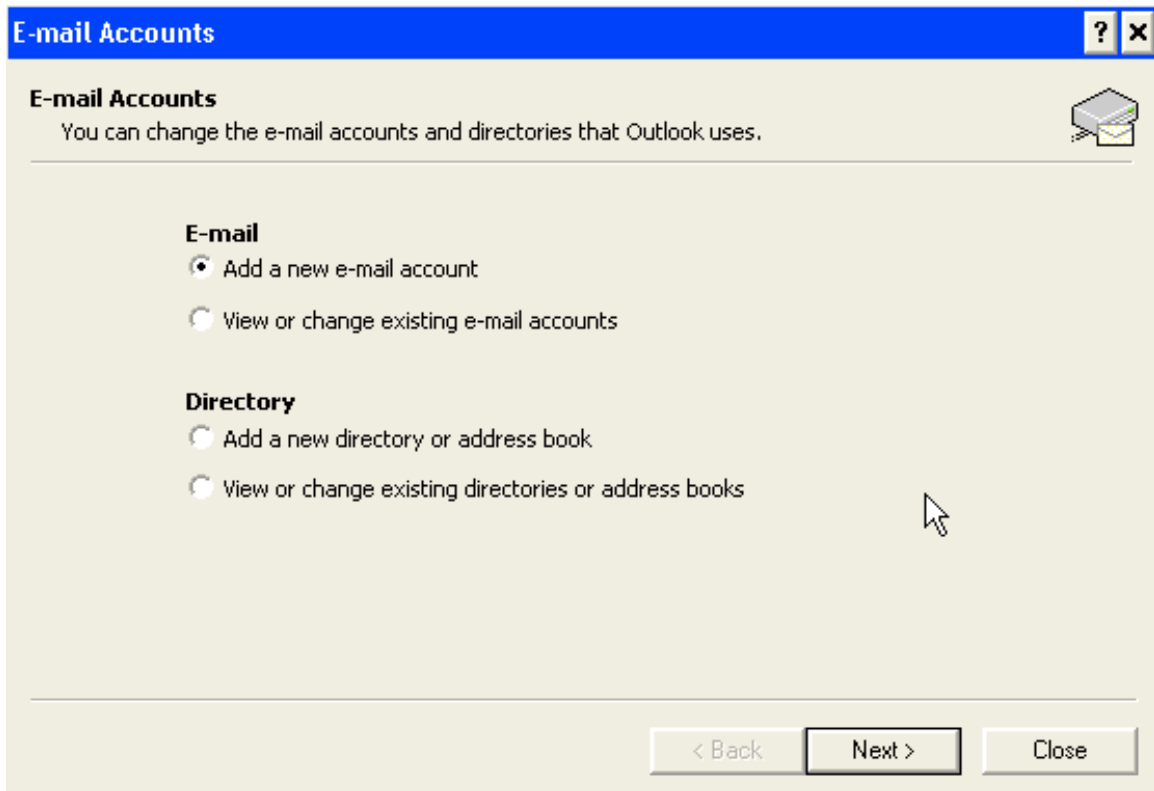


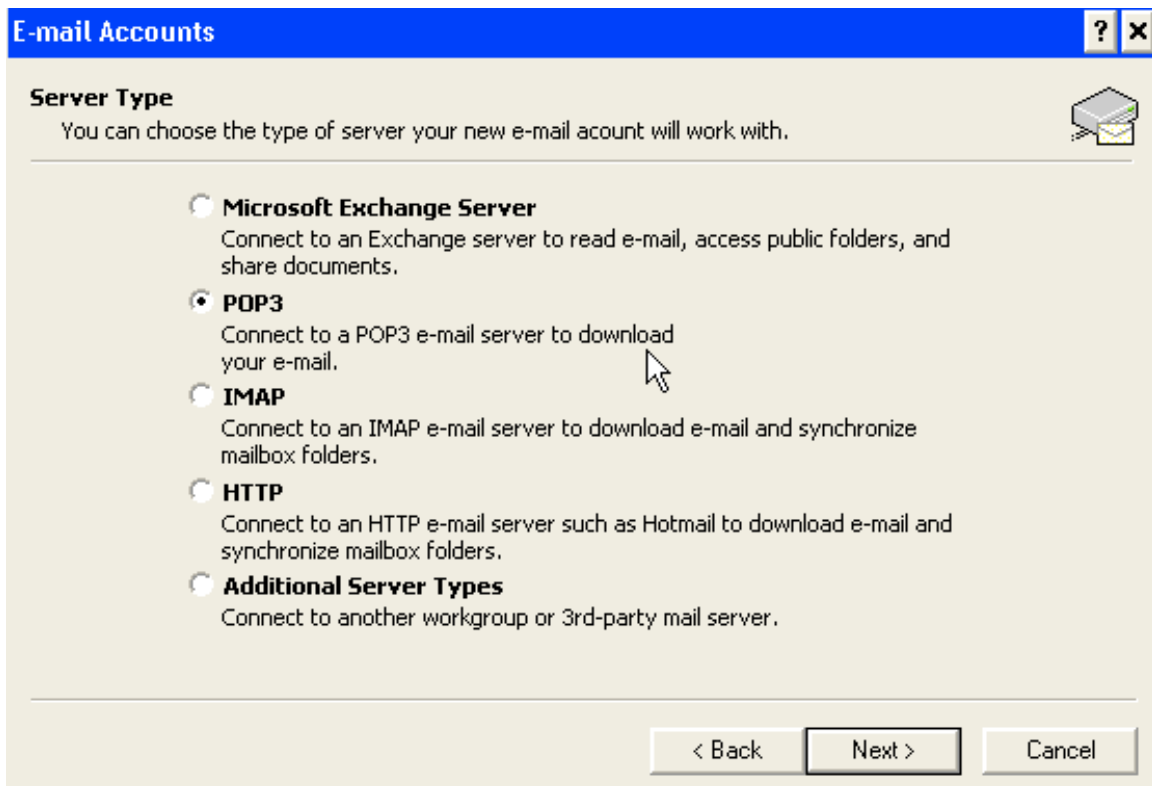
## How To Setup Outlook XP / 2003 for Eagle Email

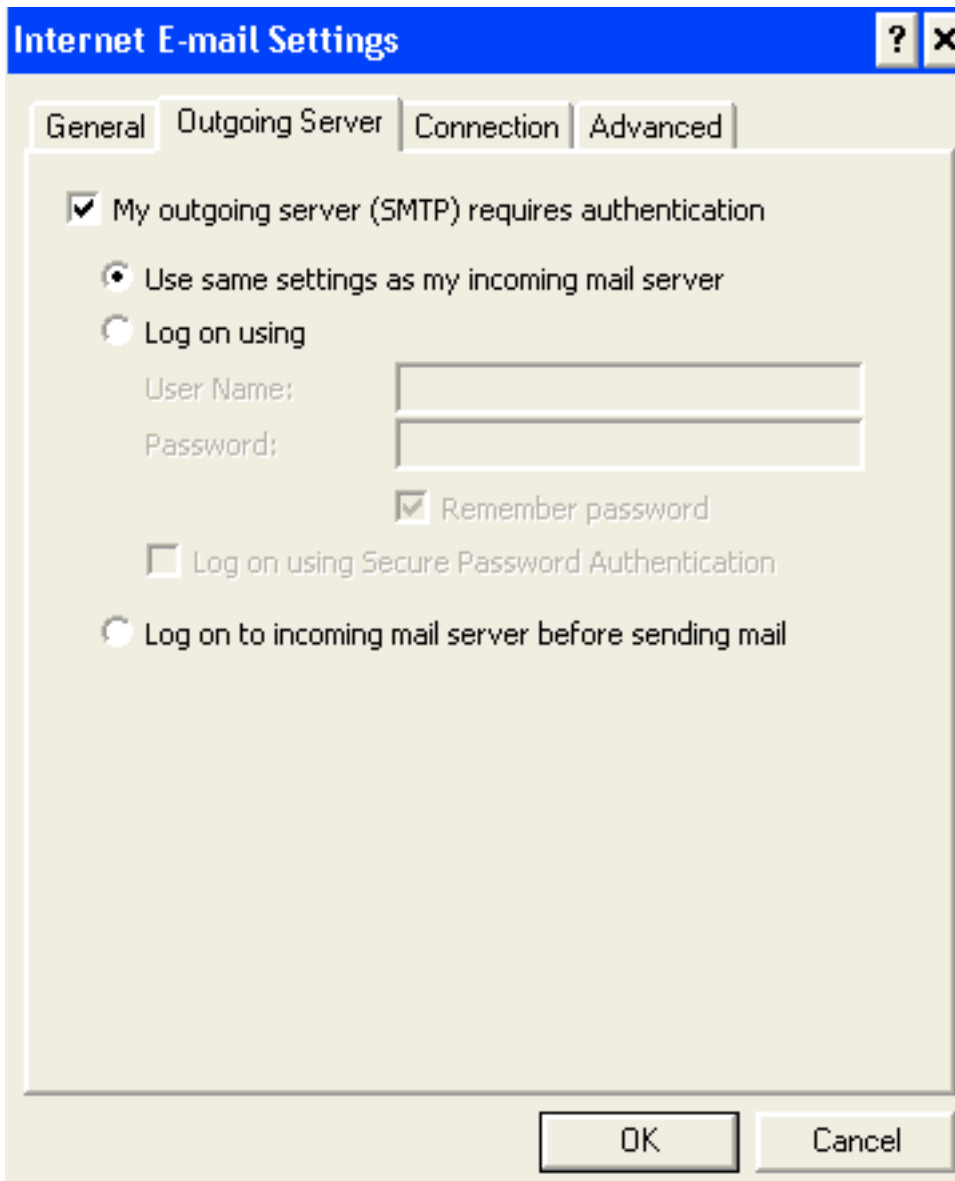

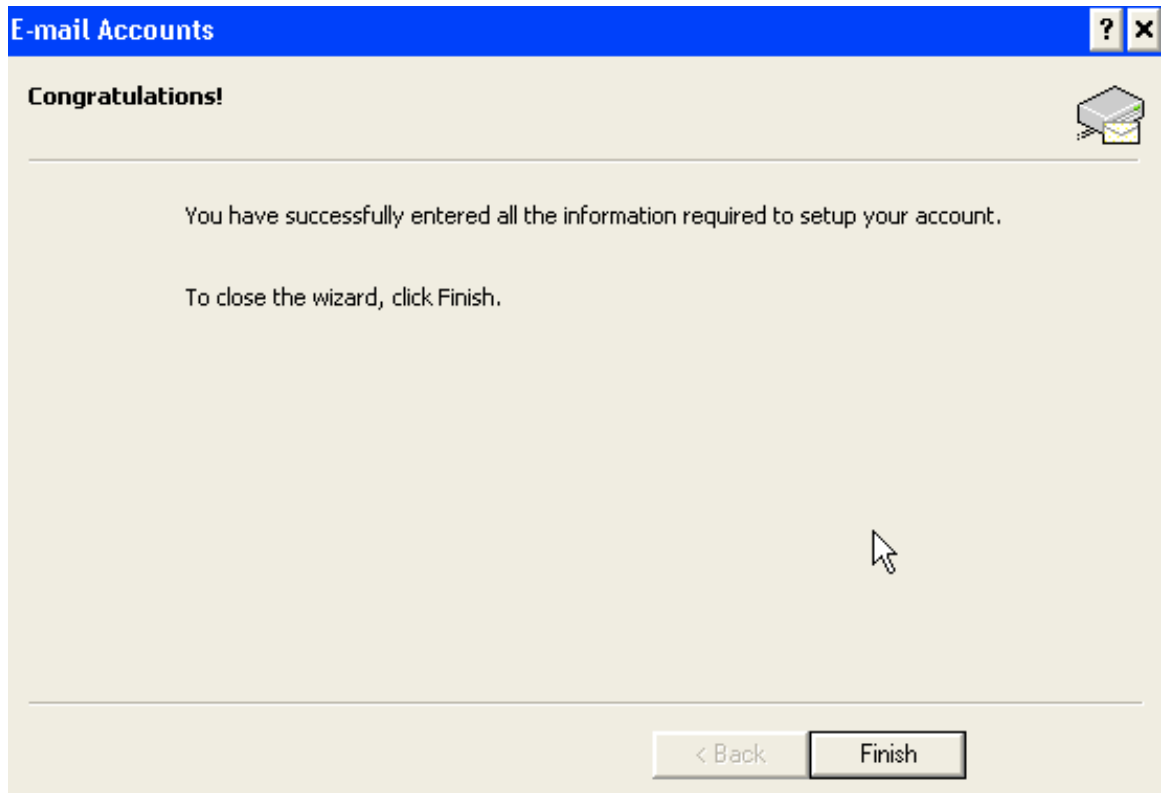
